

Mom's Morning Out: A Drop-Off Play Group

Take the break you deserve! Let the little ones have some fun while you get the to-do list done!

- Run errands (groceries, banking, the DMV)

Mondays from 9am to noon. Spots are limited, so reservations are required (all spots are filled in order of reservations received and based on space availability). **Tuition is \$20 per child, we accept children between 6 weeks and 5 years old.**

Children play in a positive and safe environment, practicing valuable social skills with other kids while also learning to adjust to a group setting away from home before any school experiences.

During MMO, kids participate in the following:

- ✓ Storytime
- ✓ Group circle – themed songs and finger plays
- ✓ Brief yoga session
- ✓ Nutritional snack
- ✓ Outside play (weather permitting)
- ✓ Creative activities

Mom's Morning Out - Procedures and Guidelines

Reservations

Call Ms. Steph at (740) 380-0438 to make your reservation. If you leave a message on the voice mail, your reservation is not complete until you have received a confirmation call. Availability is not guaranteed unless a reservation is confirmed. Please be considerate and call to cancel reservations if your child will not be able to attend so that the spot may be offered to those on the waiting list.

Pick-up/Drop-off

Your child(ren) must be signed in at drop-off and out upon pick-up. If this is their first time attending MMO, you will need to fill out a short registration form prior to leaving the child(ren) in my care.

You are expected to remain within the allotted time period for MMO; this means that your child is dropped off at or after 9am and picked up at or before noon.

Tuition

Payment is due at drop-off.* Children will not be accepted into care without pre-payment. Payment is accepted in the form of cash, check, or money order. Once your child is in attendance, tuition is not refunded (in part or in full) for early departure unless I am unable to provide care due to an emergency.

*Exception: Currently enrolled part- or full-time clients of Kinder Beginnings who are approved in the ChildCarePay electronic payment system may choose to be billed electronically for their MMO.

Illness Policy

Please be respectful of the other children in care and keep your child home if they are ill. Do not send your child if they have had vomiting, diarrhea, or fever in the past 24 hours. Should your child become ill while attending the MMO program, you (or emergency contacts) will be contacted for urgent pick up.

Snacks/Lunch

Nutritional snacks will be provided for children 12 months and older. Milk or formula must be provided for babies under 1 year old.

Note: Any personal articles brought to MMO must be labeled with the child's name (including bottles).

IMPORTANT!

Failure to abide by the above guidelines, no-shows for reserved spots, and/or failure to remain within the allotted time period for MMO may jeopardize your ability to use our services in the future.
